Resolutions

1. The Patron of the Kenya NSDI will be the President of the Republic of Kenya
2. The Head of Civil Service will chair the KNSDI National Executive Council
3. Ministry of Lands and Housing will coordinate the KNSDI initiative since the Ministry holds more than 50% of the country's core geographical data sets
4. KNSDI Secretariat will organise resource mobilisation for KNSDI activities in liaison with MoLH
5. KNSDI Secretariat will be broad based to embrace a wider cross section of KNSDI stakeholders
6. The convenors of the WGs will be incorporated in the KNSDI Secretariat
7. Key security organisations will be incorporated in the KNSDI organisational structure at all levels
8. KNSDI will encourage private enterprise among the geo-information community
